Typically, they cover the country's area and population, history, government, economy and trade, educational system, social welfare, and foreign relations. Because most of these titles appear annually or biennially, they are fairly up-to-date. Consider these the best starting point when researching a country.

Finding Books and Journal Articles. These resources offer a systematic way of identifying books and published articles by keyword, subject and author. Remember, journal indexes list references to what has been published. Often the library has linked to a full-text copy. To determine if the library owns the paper journal(s) use **HOMER -- Library Catalog**.
