How to Locate **Full Text Journals Online** via **eJournal Locator**

Introduction

EJournal Locator is a powerful database tool created by the University of Connecticut Libraries. **EJournal Locator** allows you to quickly identify, locate, and link to the electronic access point to over 20,000 full text online journals to which the Libraries subscribe. This keyword searchable index of journal titles (with dates of coverage) provides access to journals from organizations and publishers such as the American Chemical Society, the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), and Kluwer. **EJournal Locator** enables access to all online journal database collections, including but not limited to, *ABI Global*, *LexisNexis Academic*, *Factiva* (formerly *Dow Jones Interactive*), *InfoTrac*, *Science Direct*, and *JSTOR*. This database does not include the journals and resources available freely through the Internet.

To Search for a Journal Title and its Online Location by Title

Enter the **title** of the journal in the **Words in Journal Title** textbox. Click **go** or press **<Enter>**.

Example:

Words in Journal Title:

"%" is the wild-card character
(ex.: %portation or politic%)

Show results: at a time

In the results list, note the date range for the publications and select the appropriate title link.

Select the appropriate **Political Theory** using the date in your citation. Clicking on the title takes you to the journal itself or to the database it appears in. If you chose Political Theory from JSTOR, the next screen looks like this:

Browsing for Journals by Title

Browsing the titles is accomplished by selecting the first letter or number of the title in the alphabetical listing.



To Search for a Journal Title and Its Online Location by Title Keyword(s)

In the **Words in Journal Title** box, enter one or more words that are part of the desired journal title. Click **go** or press **<Enter>**.

All journals containing the keywords **politic%** (**politic, political, politics, etc.**) and **journal** appear as well as the *dates available, vendor, and library electronic location.*
